The Disarmament Committee

The antimissile shield

Recalling that the Charter of the United Nations envisages the establishment and maintenance of international peace and security with the least diversion for armaments of the world's human and economic resources,

Recalling Chapter 7 of the Charter of the United Nations,

Deeply concerned by the threat posed by international terrorism to Member States

Bearing in mind that an increase in armament could increase tensions between Member States,

Encouraging all member states to open dialogue and increase confidence-building measures,

Reminding the sovereignty of the States to define their policy according to defense and security,

Emphasizing further the need of a stable region in order for Member States to develop to their fullest potential,

The General Assembly of the United Nations:

1. *Invites* the NATO-Russia participants Council to make reports on the USA anti-missile shield in Czech Republic and Poland which is currently being developed,
2. *Encourages* the Security Council to analyze and consider reports received from the NATO-Russia participants regarding the USA anti-missile shield in Czech Republic and Poland which is currently being developed,
3. *Stresses* that sustainable efforts are needed, within the framework of the General Assembly Disarmament Committee and under the umbrella of the United Nations, to make progress on the entire range of disarmament issues,

4. *Welcomes* all confidence-building measures already undertaken by Member States in the field of missiles non-proliferation, as well as any voluntary information provided concerning the said measures,
5. *Encourages* Member States to continue to adopt confidence-building measures in the field missile non-proliferation and to provide information in that regard,
6. *Also encourages* Member States to continue the dialogue on confidence-building measures in the field of missiles,
7. *Welcomes* the establishment of a voluntary electronic database containing information provided by Member States on the number of missiles possessed,
8. *Requests* the General Assembly Disarmament Committee to seek the views of Member States on the issue of multilateralism in the area of disarmament and non-proliferation, with a focus on the domain of missiles, and to report its findings to the Security Council.
